- Recipient must certify lawful presence in the US



Bridgerland Scholarship *(for adult students)*

The Bridgerland Scholarship (for adult students) is a tuition waiver available throughout the year to several adult students enrolled in certificate programs. The award waives tuition up to \$1000 for the program in which the student is enrolled at the time of scholarship application submission, recipient selection, and assignment of scholarship funds.

Eligible Participants

- Applicants must be enrolled in an eligible* certificate program OR have completed admissions
 requirements and have a confirmed start date that is within three months following the deadline date
- Recipient will be selected on the basis of both merit and need
- Recipient must maintain the satisfactory progress and attendance policy as defined by the College
- Recipient must maintain a minimum enrollment of 15 hours per week
- Recipient must verify lawful presence in the US (Recipient is US citizen or a qualified alien and lawfully present in US)
