696.1 — OVERVIEW

Bridgerland Applied Technology College (BATC) has established the BATC Summer "Free Start" Scholarship for graduating seniors from Utah high schools in the Bear River Region. This scholarship is for:

- (1) students who would like to complete the certificate they have been enrolled in at the College, and
- (2) other seniors who are planning on attending BATC for the first time after graduation.

The BATC Summer "Free Start" Scholarship is only applicable to the tuition costs for enrollment beginning in June, July, August, and September immediately following graduation and may be subject to a maximum scholarship amount. Cannot be held or transferred.

Students who did not meet progress and attendance standards while enrolled at BATC as a high school student will not be considered for the BATC Summer "Free Start" Scholarship.

696.2 — PROCEDURES

Students will be required to complete the BATC program enrollment process (testing, orientation, etc.) in order to receive the scholarship.

Students will be required to meet satisfactory progress standards, which will be reported by program instructors to the Financial Aid Office, in order to maintain their scholarship.

In programs with waiting lists, students will be added to the list; and the scholarship will be applied if enrollment begins prior to September 30.

During the waiver period, students will be encouraged to seek other financial aid (Pell Grant and other scholarship opportunities).

Students will be required to enroll for a minimum of 15 hours per week for the duration of the scholarship.
